The Art in a Global Curriculum programme is a three-day programme led by Emma Bairstow, an experienced consultant for art in primary education. The sessions are designed to develop practical skills for the teaching of art alongside ideas for planning based on global curriculum themes. Planning support will focus on developing sequences of lessons, using a 'planning backwards' approach to create high-quality outcomes.

These are hands-on sessions; participants will learn specific techniques through practical activities, with time to explore ways they could support learning around global curriculum themes including: sustainable development, social justice, peace and conflict, and identity and diversity. Time will also be dedicated to exploring artists whose work links to these themes.

All sessions are suitable for teachers, support staff and subject leaders looking to develop subject knowledge, art and design techniques, lesson planning and whole schools approaches to art within the curriculum.
